The ACLU firmly opposes the SAVE Act as it would disenfranchise millions of eligible voters through unnecessary, restrictive documentary proof-of-citizenship requirements for voter registration.

The ACLU of Ohio played a pivotal role in the 2023 campaign to secure passage of The Ohio Reproductive Freedom Amendment.

The ACLU of Ohio recognizes a safer Ohio means investing beyond policing in our communities regardless of one's past with the criminal legal system.

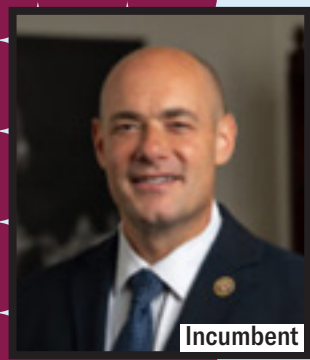

Landsman opposes the federal SAVE Act.

"If this bill [the SAVE Act] becomes law, 21 million American citizens could lose their ability to vote – including people who are already registered. We should absolutely protect our elections. Free and fair elections are the cornerstone of our democracy."

Landsman endorsed The Ohio Reproductive Freedom Amendment in 2023.

"Overturning Roe v. Wade has had devastating consequences for abortion access, birth control, and reproductive care. From city halls to state legislatures to Congress, the right to bodily autonomy is under attack. I will work with the House Pro-Choice Caucus to combat these attacks and restore these freedoms."

"Trump's approach to ICE has become a legitimate public safety threat to Americans. I'm a public safety guy and believe that people have two basic expectations for their leaders: focus on the economy and keep us safe. In Minneapolis, ICE has incited chaos. They murdered Renee Good, they tear gassed an infant, and they shut down schools. The situation is dangerous and deadly. And because the Administration is doubling down on this chaos, it's going to get more dangerous and deadly."

Landsman is focused on strengthening the relationship between our communities and public safety officers as a member of City Council.

Landsman introduced bipartisan legislation to help local law enforcement departments recruit and retain officers through federal funding programs in Congress.

As of May 2026, Conroy's stance on The Ohio Reproductive Freedom Amendment is not publicly available.

He supports comprehensive measures, including increased funding for border patrol agents, advanced surveillance technology, and completing physical barriers and the border wall where needed. He backs policies that ensure quick and fair processing of asylum claims while preventing system abuse and supports the swift deportation of violent illegal immigrant criminals.

Conroy supports critical funding for law enforcement and equipping officers with the necessary resources and training to serve safely and effectively.

Conroy supports policies that hold repeat offenders accountable and prevent dangerous individuals from being released back into the community. Opposes any measures that would cut funding or weaken police authority.
