ACLU OF OHIO POSITION

The ACLU firmly opposes the SAVE Act as it would disenfranchise millions of eligible voters through unnecessary, restrictive documentary proof-of-citizenship requirements for voter registration.

Voting is the cornerstone of our democracy.

The ACLU of Ohio played a pivotal role in the 2023 campaign to secure passage of The Ohio Reproductive Freedom Amendment.

Every person should have the freedom and power to make deeply personal decisions about their body and future, free from government interference.

The ACLU opposes additional funding for Immigration & Customs Enforcement (ICE) and calls for safeguards against racial profiling, detention of children, and warrantless arrests.

Regardless of immigration status, everyone has basic rights that are protected by the U.S. Constitution.

The ACLU of Ohio is committed to advancing community reentry by working to eliminate barriers that prevent people recently released from prison from leading successful lives.

In 2023, then Lieutenant Governor, Husted announced the Tower Technician Training program, which works with employer-partners to train soon-to-be-released inmates for jobs in the telecommunications industry.

Redpath believes in repealing all federal laws regarding consensual crimes, as well as that the Federal government should end its drug prohibition and allow the states to address this issue.

Levy is an advocate for community control of the police, abolishing Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), and banning Flock cameras.
