PLAINTIFF JAMES HANDWORK'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Plaintiff James Handwork, by and through his undersigned counsel, moves this Honorable Court for an Order granting Summary Judgment in his favor, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 56(a). "[T]here is no genuine dispute as to any material fact" in this case, and Mr. Handwork "is entitled to judgment as a matter of law." *Anderson v. Liberty Lobby, Inc.*, 477 U.S. 242, 250 (1986).

The material facts in this case are undisputed. Defendants, the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (ODRC) and its Director Gary Mohr promulgate statewide policies that control all of Ohio's prisons. They maintain a policy that hearing disabled prisoners, regardless of their individual medical needs, may only have one hearing aid, even if they need two. Mr. Handwork is a hearing-disabled prisoner with a medically diagnosed need for two hearing aids. But pursuant to their blanket policy, Defendants deny Mr. Handwork a second hearing aid, despite

medical recommendations to the contrary. Defendants withhold this necessary treatment based solely on their cruel and discriminatory policy that people in prison need only hear with one ear.

This denial is a violation Mr. Handwork's rights under the Eighth Amendment to the Constitution; the Americans with Disabilities Act; and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and the policy is unconstitutional on its face. Mr. Handwork is entitled to judgment as a matter of law in his favor as to every claim.
