The court held a telephonic status conference with counsel for parties in the within case on February 8, 2017, at 11:30 a.m.. Pending are Defendants Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (“ODRC”) and Gary C. Mohr’s First Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 12), as well as Plaintiff James Handwork’s (“Plaintiff”) Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 14). At the conference, the court granted the parties an additional thirty (30) days from the date of this Order to work toward resolving the matter.
