**ORDER**

The Emergency Motion of Proposed Intervenor-Defendant the Ohio General Assembly for Reconsideration of Opinion and Order Denying Its Motion to Intervene and Striking Its Memorandum in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction (Doc. 50) is **DENIED**.

However, notwithstanding the Court's ruling, the Ohio General Assembly may move the Court for permission to file an amicus curiae brief to ensure that its position and concerns are before the Court. *See Stupak-Thrall v. Glickman*, 226 F.3d 467, 475 (6th Cir. 2000) ("the concerns of an entity seeking intervention can be presented with complete sufficiency through [amicus curiae] participation").
