Ohio Early Voting 2014

The revised early voting period lasts from October 7 through November 3. On weekdays between October 7 and October 31, you can vote in person at your local board of elections from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., except Monday, October 13 when boards of elections will be closed for Columbus Day. On Monday, November 3, you can vote from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Golden Week

For the 2014 elections, Golden Week—the week when, in past elections, you could register and vote in person on the same day—has been eliminated.

Weekend voting

Two Saturdays are available: October 25 and November 1. Boards of elections will be open 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. One Sunday is available: November 2. Boards of elections will be open from 1 to 5 p.m.

Evening voting

Evening hours also have been eliminated.

Update: Due to an order by the U.S. Supreme Court, Ohio's early voting period has changed. This information is current as of September 29, 2014.
