How do I send records request to the Athens County Prosecutor?

Where can I find information about current cases or recent convictions?

Contact the Prosecutor's Office directly: You can call or email the office to request information about specific cases or convictions. Visit the Athens County Clerk of Courts' website for access to their online court records.
