Voting in Jail: An Organizer's Tool Kit Organizer's Campaign Checklist



Before the Drive

- Create a working plan or timeline
- Contact your local election and jail officials
- Identify the jail's voter registration procedures
- Recruit volunteers
- Complete volunteer background checks
- Schedule a volunteer training session
- Maintain a record of volunteer availability
- Obtain voter registration forms and other voting materials
- Register volunteers with the county jail
- Work with jail officials to set a date(s) for the voter registration drive
- Develop a process model for entering the jail

During the Drive

- Volunteers enter the jail
- Divide into groups
- Follow the jail's security procedures
- Meet individually with eligible voters
- Check voter forms for accuracy before leaving the jail
- Rectify any errors



After the Drive

- Deliver voter applications to local election officials
- Track voter information
